Fredrik Karl Kristian Högberg

(born February 5, 1971, in Vellinge, Sweden) is a Swedish composer and producer. He resides in the old courthouse in Nyland, Ångermanland (mid-Sweden).

Högberg grew up in Svedala, southern Sweden, and studied at the Folk High School of Framnäs, Piteå, from 1987 to 1991. He studied composition primarily under Professor Jan Sandström at Piteå School of Music (part of Luleå University of Technology). He earned a licentiate degree in performing arts at Luleå University of Technology in 2012. Since 2015, he has been teaching composition at Piteå School of Music.
